Reasons for refusal

1. The information provided does not adequately show that the proposed landfill will be above the water table.
2. Modelling has shown that there will be a significant odour impact from normal daily operations to sensitive receptors in close proximity to the proposed site.

If you're not satisfied with our decision to refuse the application you may appeal to the Welsh Ministers. You must make your appeal by **20th June 2017**.
