What can you do from here?



Why not try our waymarked trail to experience some of this woodland's best features?

UCHAFBWYNTIAU: Pont y Mwynwyr yn ei gogoniant uwchben ceunant Ystwyth. Golygfeydd o fryngaer Grogwynion - un o'r mwyaf yng Nghymru. Rhaeadr drawiadol a cheunant dwfn.

DISGRIFIAD: Llwybr cymedrol gyda nifer o ddringfeydd hir a disgyniadau serth. Bydd yr arwyneb yn arw ac efallai'n wlyb mewn manau. Cymerwch ofal ger y ceunant. Argymhellir esgidiau cerdedd sydd â gafael dda. Bydd angen lefel dda o ffitrwydd ar gyfer y daith gerdded hon.

Cadwch ar y llwybr wrth ddychwelyd - disgyniadau serth i lawr y clogwyni a'r ceunant. Gall llif yr afon fod yn gyflym iawn ar ôl glaw trwm a gall godi'n gyflym iawn - cadwch draw.

HIGHLIGHTS: The dramatic Miners' bridge high above the Ystwyth gorge. Views of Castell Grogwynion hillfort - one of the largest in Wales. A spectacular waterfall and a deep river gorge.

DESCRIPTION: A moderate walk with numerous long climbs and steep descents. The surface will be rough and possibly wet in places. Take care near the gorge. Walking boots with a good grip recommended. You need a good level of fitness for this walk.

Keep to the path on the return leg of the walk - steep drops down cliffs and the gorge. The river can be very fast flowing after heavy rain and can rise very quickly - please keep away.
